Minutes of the 60th Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) held on Wednesday, 30th October 2024 at 5:30 PM at S.P. Bhat Hall, Institution of Engineers (India), J.L.B. Road, Mysore

1. Welcome and Reading of the Notice

The **60th Annual General Body Meeting (AGM)** of the Institution of Engineers (India), Mysore Local Centre, commenced at 5:30 PM & the meeting was called to order by Past Chairman Er.B.S.Prabhakara.

Members, including **Past Chairmen, Past Honorary Secretaries, Senior Members, and Executive Committee Members** were warmly welcomed by the Hon.Secretary.

The meeting was presided over by **Dr.Deepu R, Chairman**.

The **Honorary Secretary, Dr. S.A Mohan Krishna**, then read out the **Notice convening the 60th AGM**, issued in accordance with Regulation 6 of the Institution of Engineers (India).

The Meeting notice with the agenda calling 60th Annual General meeting was unanimously approved.

2. To Confirm the minutes of the Minutes of the 59th Annual General Meeting of IEL,Mysore

The **Honorary Secretary, Dr. S. A Mohan Krishna**, read the minutes of the **59th Annual General Body Meeting** held on 31st October 2023.

The minutes included details of previous year's reports, activities, auditor appointment, and declaration of election results for 2023–25.

After review, the General Body **confirmed and adopted the minutes** of the 59th AGM without any corrections.

3.To Receive , Consider and Adopt the Annual Report on the Activities for the Year 2023–24

The **Honorary Secretary** presented the **Annual Report** for the year 2023–24.

Highlights of the Report:

- The Committee met **four times** during the reporting period.
- A total of **31 programmes** were conducted between **November 2023 and October 2024**, including technical lectures, professional seminars, workshops, cultural events, and outreach activities.
- Invitations were sent through **email**, SMS and details were uploaded to the official website.
- **Membership strength** as of **31 March 2024** stood at **3,141**.
- **Library holdings** reached **4,064** books, journals, and technical papers.
- The **Guest House** with seven rooms was well maintained, with improved occupancy and feedback from members.
- The **audio-visual and infrastructure facilities**, including solar-powered systems, LCD projector, and PA setup, ensured self-sufficiency during events.
- The official website (www.ieimysore.org.in) was regularly updated.

The Annual Report on activities for the year 2023–24 was **received, considered, and unanimously adopted** by the General Body.

4. To Receive, Consider and adopt Audited Statement of Accounts for the Year Ending 31 March 2024

The **Honorary Secretary, Dr. S.A Mohan Krishna**, presented the **audited statement of accounts** for the financial year ending 31 March 2024.

- A query was raised regarding the **security charges**, amounting to approximately ₹6,00,000.
- The Secretary clarified that the security services were **outsourced** through an external agency, and the expenses were duly audited.
- Members suggested that future contracts for such services may be obtained through **open quotations/tenders** for greater transparency and cost-effectiveness.

After due consideration, the **audited accounts** for the year 2023–24 were **adopted unanimously** by the General Body.

5. Appointment of Auditor for the Year 2024–25 and to Fix their Remuneration

The AGM considered the appointment of auditors for the ensuing financial year.

- The existing auditors, **M/s. Hariharan & Co.**, were recommended for reappointment.
- It was proposed to enhance the remuneration by **10%** in recognition of their consistent and satisfactory work.

The General Body **approved the reappointment** of **M/s. Hariharan & Co.** as Auditors for the year 2024–25 with a **10% increase in remuneration**.

Member Suggestions and General Discussions

Several valuable points were raised during the open session:

1. Obituary References:

- Members suggested that **photographs of departed members** be included in the Annual Report as a mark of tribute.
- The proposal was appreciated by the House and agreed upon for future inclusion.

2. Communication with Members:

- Some members pointed out that AGM notices were received very close to the meeting date.
- It was proposed that communication be strengthened by sharing AGM notices and event invitations through the **official WhatsApp group** in addition to postal and email communication.

3. Membership Drive:

- The importance of enrolling new corporate and student members was stressed.
- Members suggested outreach initiatives in engineering colleges and institutions.

4. Security Services:

- It was again reiterated that quotations from multiple agencies should be sought to ensure transparent outsourcing.

The Chairman took note of all the suggestions and assured that necessary actions will be taken.

6. Address by the Chairman & Vote of thanks

The **Chairman, Dr. Deepu R.**, addressed the General Body.

He extended heartfelt thanks to the Past Chairmen, Past Secretaries, Committee Members, Staff, and all Corporate Members for their cooperation and contribution throughout the year.

He highlighted:

- The importance of **collective effort and teamwork** in strengthening the Mysore Local Centre.
- The Centre's readiness to host **large-scale technical seminars, workshops, and national-level conferences**.
- Appreciation to the members and volunteers who contributed to maintaining the campus and organizing successful events such as Engineers' Day.
